The Cowboy Jack Clement Show Set For Nov. 21

NASHVILLE, Tenn. (November 2008) – **The Cowboy Jack Clement Show** is set for **Friday, Nov. 21** at **Ernest Tubb's Texas Troubadour Theater** ((2416 Music Valley Drive in Nashville, TN)), and it could be the start of something beautiful.

Based on his successful 2003 Artist-in-Residence stint at the Country Music Hall of Fame and Museum, the legendary Cowboy Jack Clement is preparing the show in hopes of continuing on a weekly basis.

Clement, whose ties to landmark American music are too numerous to list, has invited well-known friends and a few stellar musicians to join in the fun, including **Shawn Camp, Billy Burnett, Thom Bresh, Lillie Mae the Jypsi Violinist, Alison Clement** and **The Tennessee Mafia Jug Band** (with **Leroy Troy**).

"We had such a great time at the Hall of Fame and people have asked me when we can do this again," Clement said. "We thought it would be fun to put something together that could become an ongoing, regular event.

Joining **Cowboy's Ragtime Band** will be Camp (guitar), **Rick Lanow** (drums), **Toni Schulster** (electric bass), **David Roe** (bass), and **Bobby Wood** (piano).

"I want to put something together that will be great entertainment," Clement said. "I want to build a congregation."

Admission to the show, which will begin at 8 p.m., is \$15.
